DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Spray Marking: Suitable for use with both liquid and powder herbicide products and can be used to help identify sprayed areas.
Foam Marker Dye: Where a coloured foam is required for foam markers, add at the recommended rate to dilute foam mixture.

RATE OF APPLICATION

RATE	VOLUME	CRITICAL COMMENTS
5-10mL	Per 10 litres of spray solution	Use higher rate if more intense colour marking is required.
50-100mL	Per 100 litres of spray solution	
20-30mL	Per 10 litres of spray solution	Will convert white foam to pink for easier identification in specific situations.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS: A red marker dye to assist in the identification of sprayed areas.

When used as a foam marker colouring agent, white foam will become pink in colour to assist identification.

DO NOT allow spray drift to come into contact with the paint work of motor vehicles or other materials as marking can be permanent.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS Important Note: When using in conjunction with Amine based products such as Weed Force A-Mine 625 Broadleaf Herbicide, 2,4-D Amine 500 and MCPA 500, ensure that WEED FORCE RHODAMINE RED MARKER DYE is thoroughly mixed with the water before adding any herbicide. Then slowly add the herbicide whilst the spray tank is being agitated. Thoroughly clean out tank and equipment after each use. If product residue is left in equipment colouration of subsequent sprays can be expected.
